SCHOOL MEALS

The cost of school meals is now £2.20 per day or £11 per week.

Payment should be made in advance, using the ParentPay website or with a debit or credit card at the school office.

Please also note that debts of more than £21 are unsustainable for the school. If you allow arrears to grow to this amount you will be asked to provide a packed lunch every day until the debt is cleared.


