### A Message From the Friends of Holbeach (FoH)

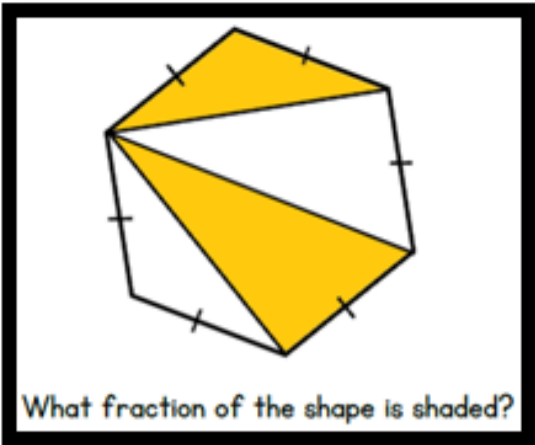
On Thursday 11th October the FoH will be holding its Annual General Meeting at 8pm in the school house on the corner of Holbeach and Doggett Roads.

Aisha is buying doughnuts.

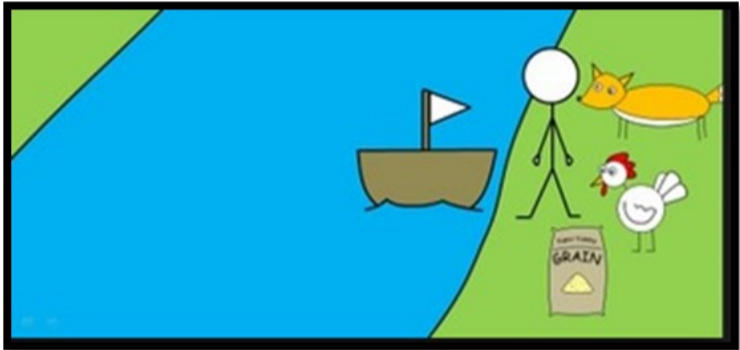
Doughnut Palace
