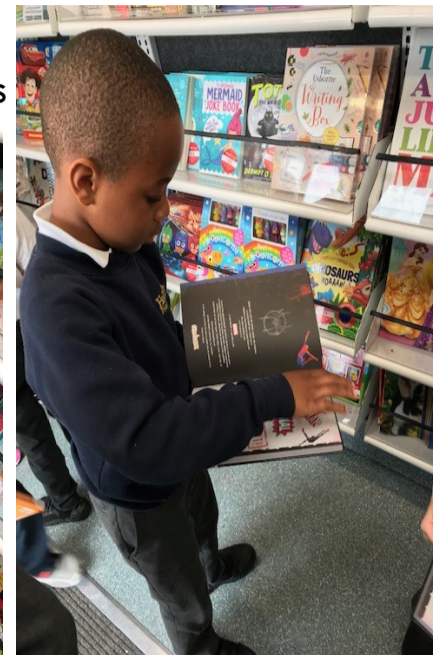
The Book People Book Bus
