

## Topic Title: Paws, Claws and Roars

### To engage the children we will:

- Become Historians and explore fossils to find out about the past
- Visit Dinosaur Forest at Port Lympne Safari Park.

### What the children will know by the end of the topic:

- That there are/were different types of safari animals/dinosaurs
- That dinosaurs and safari animals live/lived in different places in the world
- That dinosaurs lived a long time ago
- That dinosaurs died out
- That fossils tell us information about creatures from the past
- That we can use information books to find out about the past

### What the children will learn to do during the topic:

- To identify and classify dinosaurs/safari animals by different criteria
- To be able to identify countries on a world map
- To order significant events chronologically
- To be able to ask and answer questions about our world past and present
- To observe objects closely and record what they see
- To identify the features of an information book and create a class book
