No Jewellery Please

An increasing number of children at Holbeach are coming to school wearing small pieces of jewellery. As we are sure you are aware:

Lewisham Education Authority recommends that children do not wear any earrings other than stud earrings, rings, bracelets, necklaces, chains or any other type of jewellery at school on the grounds of health and safety.

In line with this recommendation, at Holbeach, we will ensure that any jewellery worn is removed and kept in the school office for collection by a parent/carer.

Mobile Telephones

May we remind you that pupils should not use mobile phones within the school grounds and should not bring in mobile phones (or any other form of recording device) to school, except in Year 6.

In such circumstances, the child's phone must be kept in the school office/locked classroom storage until they go home. Mobile phones are also not permitted on Educational Visits or School Journey.

Any mobile phone seen on site will be removed and kept in the school office for collection by a parent/carer.

Year 6 - Lewisham Football Competition
