



WORLD BOOK DAY

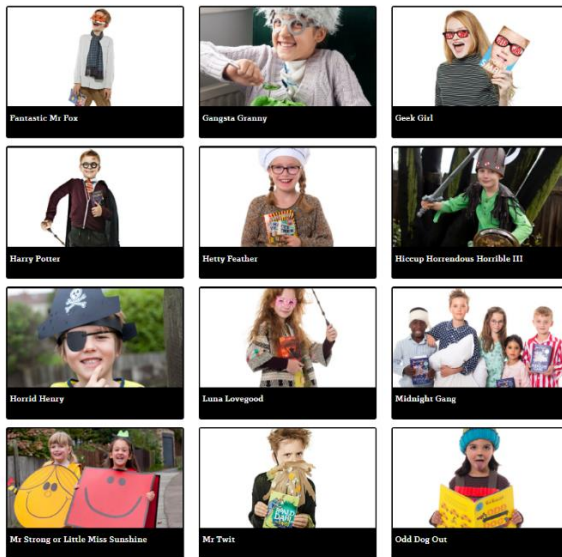
We have a very exciting day planned for this year's World Book Day (Thursday 3rd March).

DRESS UP AS... THE BFG

YOU WILL NEED

- ✓ Paper plates
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Masking tape
- ✓ Hairband
- ✓ Double-sided tape
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ String
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ White, yellow and a little pink paint
- ✓ Paintbrush
- ✓ Downloadable ear template

TO MAKE THE EARS

1. Place two paper plates one on top of the other. Using the ears template to guide you, cut out two ear shapes.
2. Mix together the white, yellow and a little pink paint to make a flesh colour. Paint both sides of each plate and leave to dry.
3. Cut four pieces of string the same length, to make the BFG 'hair' and attach them to the top of the hairband with masking tape. Then paint these 'hair' with brown paint.
