

## Topic Title: Globetrotting

To engage the children we will:

- Explore Masks from Around the World in a hands-on workshop.
- Design and make wheeled vehicles that are powered by an electrical source.
- Find out about the children's own family heritage.

What the children will **know** by the end of the topic:

- The names of the world's seven continents and some of the countries within them.
- The importance of the Amazon Rainforest and our responsibility as global citizens to reduce our carbon footprint.
- How to build a functioning electrical circuit that includes a motor.
- Comparing the human and physical geographical features of where we live to other places around the world.
- How meteorologists use computers to measure and present data about the weather.

What the children will learn **to do** during the topic:

- Use maps and atlases to research the human and physical geographical aspects of a country.
- Design and build a wheeled vehicle with electrical components.
- Manipulate clay to create 3D masks inspired by various cultures.
- Test a circuit and suggest materials suitable to use as conductors and insulators.
- Measure, record and predict the weather.
- Present our own weather forecast

**This term we will be discussing the following in SRE:**

- How bodies change during puberty
- How puberty can affect emotions and feelings
- How personal hygiene routines change during puberty

The memorable experience at the end of the topic will be:

**“An International Celebration Day”**

**The children will plan for and prepare this event.**

**To support your child's learning, you could:**

- Research different countries using the Internet, information books, maps and atlases.
- Share your family history and culture.
- Discuss personal safety focusing on road safety and electricity safety.
- Visit art galleries or museums, with a focus on masks and different countries and cultures. (If restrictions are lifted)
